Introduction

The Great and Awesome God Almighty is so glorious, so wonderful, and so powerful, we cannot even comprehend it.

He loves every person on the earth and wants them to spend eternity with Him in heaven, a place so glorious, words cannot express it.

His Presence fills heaven and is available to every person on the earth. He Himself is so glorious, so beautiful, and so wonderful . . . and more . . . that those who make it heaven will spend eternity experiencing Jehovah God Almighty, the Father of Glory . . . and His Son Jesus the Christ, the Lord God Almighty . . . The reality is that we are not to approach the Father directly. If anyone sees His face, he or she will die. We approach Him and find Him through Jesus, who is both the Son of God and God Almighty. The Trinity is a holy, sacred, glorious truth . . . the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

A man of God once wrote, “God came to earth as a man and justified Himself to the world.”

So, if we have a book of “Jesus Christ’s Promises,” the book should actually include ALL the promises in the entire Bible, both the Old Testament and the New Testament.

For now, this book includes most of Jesus Christ’s promises from the Gospels and the Book of Revelation. The promises are summarized in a title before the actual quote of Jesus.

The Kingdom of God

Jesus preached and taught more about the kingdom than about any other topic. The kingdom of God and heaven is literally God Himself, the Presence of God, the Presence of Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit. The Presence of God is so beautiful and so glorious, human words cannot express Him. The following are just some of the kingdom promises.

From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand (has come near)." Matthew 4:17

"He answered and said to them, "Because it has been given to you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it has not been given." Matthew 13:11

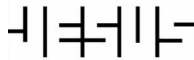

FOUR

Relationship with Jesus Christ

Living Water

Jesus teaches that there are three main phases in a believer's relationship with Him through the Holy Spirit. Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No man comes to the Father except through Me." (John 14:6)

He teaches about this truth in the Gospel of John, Chapters 3, 4, and 7. Below, the three portions of scripture are marked (1), (2) and (3).

Born of Water and the Spirit, One Can Enter the Kingdom of God (1)

Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Do not marvel that

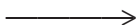
I said to you, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit." John 3:5-8

Ask Jesus, Receive Living Water

Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water." John 4:10

Drink the Living Water, Never Thirst

Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. . ." John 4:13-14

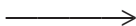

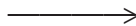

Faith

In the Gospels, the second most frequent topic Jesus preached and taught about was "faith." The Greek word for "faith" and "to believe" is "pistis" (noun) and "pisteuo" (verb) which means "trust, reliance." Faith is simple: it is trusting in and relying on God to do what He promises.

But Jesus turned around, and when He saw her He said, "Be of good cheer, daughter; your faith has made you well." Matthew 9:22

Then He touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith let it be to you." Matthew 9:29

Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour. Matthew 15:28

Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be

done for you." And his servant was healed that same hour. Matthew 8:13

And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction." Mark 5:34

Then Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well." And immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus on the road. Mark 10:52

So the Lord said, "If you have faith as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." Luke 17:6

Revealed Will and Secret Will of God

The revealed and secret will of God is simple, yet it is also a deep mystery. Moses said: "The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law" (Deuteronomy 29:29).

In Matthew 6:9, Jesus taught about this truth. There is the revealed will of God and the secret will of God. We know from His word that God wants to save and heal people – but the secret is when and how He will save and heal them.

As Jesus taught, we are to pray for God's secret will in heaven to be done on earth. When we follow Jesus through the Holy Spirit, we are able to move from God's revealed will into God's secret will.

Ask, Seek, Knock . . . Receive, Find, Opened

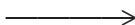

The Beatitudes

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus presents eight blessings and promises, today called The Beatitudes. The meaning of the word "beatitude" is "supreme blessedness, exalted happiness."

The blessings begin with the word "blessed," which in the Greek is the word "makarios," which means "happy, fortunate."

"Blessed are the poor in spirit [Amplified: spiritual beggars; those devoid of spiritual arrogance, those who regard themselves as insignificant], for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 5:3

"Blessed are those who mourn [over their sins and repent], for they shall be comforted." Matthew 5:4

“Blessed are the meek [consecrated to God], for they shall inherit the earth.” Matthew 5:5

“Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.” Matthew 5:6

“Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.” Matthew 5:7

“Blessed are the pure in heart [one single devotion: to God], for they shall see God.” Matthew 5:8
